** (Subject to change) In partnership with the Vermont Training Program, Department of Economic Development, we are able to offer a discount of half-price to students in the Healthcare sector who will be directly enhancing their education and skills training in their current job. Students must currently earn at least \$13.04/hr. with benefits or 16.30/hr. without benefits to be eligible. Students must complete the course to receive the discount and provide us with their social security number.

This SkillTech course is designed to prepare dental assistants for an endorsement in radiology in the dental office. Emphasis is placed on understanding and practicing the essentials of radiographic clinical procedures.

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR ADMISSION:

Participant must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or equivalent.

- **Participant must have been officially registered with the Board of Dental Examiners as a Traditional Dental Assistant for six months and must have completed at least six consecutive months of employment as a dental assistant in a clinical setting prior to taking this course.**

Participant must attach a copy of Vermont State Registration to the application or it will be returned.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND:

1. Lecture Session on Mar. 24 (7 hours)

A seven hour lecture session covering theory and techniques used in exposing dental radiographs.

2. Preclinical Session (5 hours)

The preclinical session will be scheduled on Mar. 27 or Mar. 29.

3. Clinical Session on Mar. 31 (2 hours)

- Expose a complete FMX on a patient. **It will be your responsibility to provide a patient.**
- Take a written dental radiology exam (must achieve 70% to pass course) and must pass the clinical test out with a grade of 80% or higher.
- Student should pick a time on the registration form that is convenient to them.

NOTE: Students will be admitted and scheduled into the Radiology course on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is a limit of 12 students in this course, and on the test out day, there will be a limit of 3 students scheduled for each time.
